Summary:

The person in this position is responsible, as part of the Town of Twisp staff, for the general maintenance, repair, and day to day operations of the Ernst O. Wagner Memorial Pool. These operations include: Water chemistry, lifeguard supervision, scheduling staff, swim lessons, staffing and organizing programs and special events.

Work Environment:

Work is generally performed at The Ernst O. Wagner Memorial Pool Building. On and around the entire pool deck in and out of the pool office with frequent visits to the Pool's mechanical room. The Manager will need to on occasion leave the pool to make copies or visit the bank to make change for the cash register.

Essential Functions:

- Hiring and supervising of Lifeguards.
- Organize and schedule Training for Certification of all lifeguards.
- Prepare a weekly work schedule to assure proper swimmer-guard ratio.
- Perform Employee evaluation of all lifeguards.
- Scheduling of swim lessons, water aerobics, lap swim and private parties.
- Keep records of all pass holders and swim lesson participants.
- Assist the Swim Team.
- Attend and supervise lifeguards, swimmers, and spectators at all home swim meets.
- Constantly monitor and maintain chemical levels in the pool to keep within state regulations.
- Minor maintenance within the facility.

Other Duties:

- Back washing of the sand filter.
- Frequent inspections of all pumps hoses and piping in Mechanical room.
- Report any mechanical issues to Public Works staff immediately.
- Keep all pool chemicals stocked.
- Perform continuous water chemistry tests to maintain a safe and sanitary Pool.
- Order and stock supplies for shower rooms.
- Maintain log sheets, schedules, maintenance records and keep Public Works informed of any major maintenance issues.
- Be on site for Department of Health State Inspector visit.
- Manager may be subject to weekend, early morning or late-night calls from lifeguards and others.

Education and Experience:

High School Diploma or Equivalency.

Licensing and Certifications:

The following Certifications must be obtained prior to Pool opening.

First Aid/CPR/AED

Possession of a valid Washington State Drivers License with a driving record free of serious or frequent violations is an essential requirement of the position. A background check will also be completed.

Knowledge Skills and Abilities

Must possess knowledge of principles and practices, methods, materials and equipment used in the operation and maintenance of Municipal Swimming Facility.

Ability to follow specific oral and written instructions; ability to read, write, and perform mathematical calculations required as needed by the position; ability to work independently with minimal direct supervision; ability to learn to operate all equipment and perform all duties required of the position. Ability to work effectively with fellow employees and the general public; ability to accurately and legibly document completed work.
