**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TWISP,
WASHINGTON AMENDING RESOLUTION #10-475 THE SIX YEAR CAPITAL
FACILITIES PLAN FOR 2011 THROUGH 2016**

WHEREAS, a Capital Facilities Plan is essential in planning for capital expenditures and for the construction of public facilities; and

WHEREAS, a Capital Facilities Plan aids the Town in developing the needed financing for capital expenditures and the construction of public facilities in the application for grants and loans from state and federal programs; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Twisp, Washington, being the legislative body of said Town, did hold a public hearing on the review of the 2011 through 2016 Capital Facilities Plan on October 12, 2010; and



WHEREAS, the Town Council as of May 24, 2011 became aware of an emergency situation concerning the Town Hall roof in regards to public health and safety that requires immediate repair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Twisp, Washington, that the amended Six Year Capital Facilities Plan for the remaining ensuing six calendar years, 2011 through 2016, is hereby adopted.
