

## RESOLUTION #10-464

**A RESOLUTION** of the Town of Twisp with regard to sponsoring the Twisp Public Development Authority request to join the Association of Washington Cities Employee Benefit Trust.

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Twisp established the Twisp Public Development Authority created by Resolution as authorized by RCW 35.21.730; and

**WHEREAS**, the Twisp Public Development Authority provides an independent legal entity under RCW 35.21.730-.755 and the Enabling Ordinance to acquire, own, undertake, assist with, otherwise facilitate, and advocate for the redevelopment, improvement, management and maintenance of property, including two parcels of land currently owned by the United States Forest Service (the "Town Center Property"), and to undertake other projects of the Town as determined necessary by the Town Council. The priority focus of the Authority shall be the acquisition, ownership, redevelopment, restoration, improvement, management and maintenance of the Town Center Property for civic, business, recreational and/or residential purposes. Consistent with applicable law and utilizing all lawful means, the Authority shall also work with for-profit and not-for-profit entities to facilitate and maximize private sector participation in such projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Twisp Public Development Authority would like to participate in the Association of Washington Cities Employee Benefit Trust benefits program as a quasi-municipal entity; and

**WHEREAS**, the Association of Washington Cities Employee Benefit Trust requires that a city member of the Association of Washington Cities Employee Benefit Trust sponsor a non-city entity's request before the non-city entity can participate in the Association of Washington Cities Employee Benefit Trust benefit programs.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved:

1. The Town of Twisp, with this resolution, sponsors the Twisp Public Development Authority of Okanogan County's request for application to join the Association of Washington Cities Employment Benefit Trust as a non-city entity.
2. The Town of Twisp requests that the Twisp Public Development Authority of Okanogan County be allowed membership into the Association of Washington Cities Employee Benefit Trust.
