

RESOLUTION #11-489

A RESOLUTION of the Town of Twisp, Washington, declaring support and adoption of the updated Okanogan County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (OC-CEMP) as part of the Town's local emergency management program.

WHEREAS, Chapter 38.52 RCW and WAC Chapter 118-30 require counties and cities within the State of Washington to establish emergency management organizations and emergency plans for the protection of persons and property in the event of disaster and to provide for the coordination of emergency management functions with other public agencies and organizations; and

WHEREAS, the County has previously prepared a CEMP; and


WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes that in accordance with state law, the CEMP must be submitted to Washington State Emergency Management Division (WAEMD) every four years for review; and

WHEREAS, the CEMP has been updated, reviewed by WAEMD, and is ready for formal adoption by the Town Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the Town Council of Twisp, Washington, does hereby adopt the Okanogan County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan, dated January 2011, as the official plan providing emergency services when protection of life, property, and the environment cannot be accomplished as a normal daily function of the local government.
