

**RESOLUTION #13-512**

**A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Twisp, Washington in accordance with 18.50.100 directing the Town of Twisp Planning Commission to conduct the process necessary to amend Title 18 of the Twisp Municipal Code to eliminate the prohibition of firearms.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Washington in RCW 9.41.290 and 9.41.300 provides regulations related to firearms; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has received correspondence from the Second Amendment Foundation that requests that the Town review and revise the Twisp Municipal Code to eliminate prohibitions on firearms in temporary markets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council requested comments from the Town Attorney and Police Chief regarding the allowance of firearms in temporary markets; and

**WHEREAS**, at the regular Council meeting on January 8, 2013 the Town Council reviewed the information provided by the Police Chief, Town Attorney and Second Amendment Foundation and determined that the Twisp Municipal Code would be amended to address the issue.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Council of the Town of Twisp, in compliance with 18.50.100 TMC is directing the Planning Commission as follows:

**Section 1.00** That the Planning Commission conduct the necessary process to review and schedule a public hearing on amendments to 18.15.100 (2) (f) TMC to eliminate the reference to firearms.

**Section 2.00** That the Planning Commission, upon conclusion of the Hearing provide the Council with a recommendation for amendment of 18.15.100 (2) (f).
